



Area transportation planning agency looks for public input

The metropolitan planning organization through which PARTA receives federal funding is updating its public participation plan. The Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) seeks public participation as it selects which highway, public transit, bike, and pedestrian projects are worthy of receiving federal funds.
